

Anne's White Columns Inn was originally built in 1930 as a Christian Science church. Anne Bahr purchased the church in 1986 and turned it into a 10-room Bed & Breakfast. The maple trees in front of the church were replaced with King Crimson maples, holly bushes were added to flank the entrance, and the cedar hedge between the church and neighboring home were replaced by the Front Corner Garden. The Middle Garden was added in 1993 to serve as a perennial bed for cut flowers. The Patio Garden followed, and was greatly enlarged in 2012.

The Back Border Garden was developed in 1998 as a deep shade garden under the maple trees, with dappled to full sun perennials along the gravel parking area. The Front Garden was planted in 2008 and continues to expand with both perennials and annuals.

We hope you will enjoy our gardens and return often to delight in the new additions each year.






